As everywhere on earth now, we are concern about the corona virus too. Current there is an actual need of clean disposable gloves, disposable masks for doctors, sanitizers as well as soap in the village dispensarys who we stay closely in contact with. They rely on help, to be able providing the required hygiene-interventions against the virus. For the moment they do, due to financial reasons, not have the possibility to guarantee enough safety.

Following you can read some brief reports from two families we currently cared for:

Amidou

A single uncle who takes care of his brother's son whom's father died. With Kipepeo's help he was able to build a suitable, stable barn for his pigs. This in turn enables him to increase the number of piglets. The pig he already had was admitted and sufficient food and water was provided. At the moment it is important to train him how to do business properly and educate him on how to earn enough money to be able caring for his nephew.
