

FAMILY UPDATE

Moving from the Masai to another community which's place is called Kaloleni, we meet a variety of new people. Those Families face different problems, have unique dreams and own possibilities to grow. Right now we do a lot of social work in order to get to know each other well before we empower our new Families. As well we do still visit the previous communities to evaluate their growth. It is always heartwarming to see them again.

SUSTAINABILITY

Kipepeo owns one hectare of fertile land since May 2022. It can be used from October 2022. The next steps for this will be:

- Build a fence around the land.
- Laying a water pipe
- An electricity cable from the village to our land
- Building a small house
- Building shelters for the animals
- Planting trees and the land
- Keeping the first animals

We are happy to accept financial help for this.

KIWAVI HOME provides shelter and work to two people out of the community. It is hosting visitors from many different countries and donates by now every month 10% of their earnings to Kipepeo Family Foundation. Students from abroad absolving an internship in Moshi are living in a safe home during their stay.
