FOR YOU

With a heart full of gratitude, we share a few events of the past half year with you here. Without your support we could not have done this work. Every story you read here, shows part of what we have been able to do with your help.

FAMILY SUPPORT

Supporting families has been our main work since the foundation. In the last six months, our team has done their daily social work and helped the families to become self-sufficient with various solutions. The goal is always that the children can grow up with their relatives and that the responsible persons (parents) are financially and socially able to provide for the basic needs of all family members.

Examples:

- Capital and assistance for the cultivation of rice, corn or beans.
- Donation of livestock
- Health-related aid
- Start-up capital and support to start small businesses (selling vegetables at the market, running a small shop)
- Construction/renovation of living space

KIWAVI HOME

In our hostel we accommodate guests from all over the world. People are climbing Kilimanjaro, planning a trip to the nearby national parks or do voluntary work in Tanzania.

The salaries of the staff, renovations and any other costs that are needed for the hostel's operation are fully covered by the hostel's income.

Since January 2023, the Hostel donates5 USD per person per night directly to the Kipepeo Family Foundation.

BOYS; STREETOUTREACH

Twice a month we eat together with the boys living on the street. Aim is to gain their trust and create together with them a future that is safe and worth living. Reunification with their family of origin and the opportunity to do an education with our project "Go to school with Kipepeo" are helps we provide.

Facts:

- Most of the children living on the street are boys. Girls get involved in prostitution or work in a household for accommodation and food.
- A high percentage of children affected by the street are not orphans. They usually have living family members.
- Some of the children live on the street part-time (to earn money and living), others full-time (included sleeping).
- Reasons why children are running away from home are: Lack of provision of basic needs, abuse of any kind, lack of finances.
